



## **St. John's Archdiocese Inc. Cemetery Operations - Private Committals**

*May 17, 2024*

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Families can arrange private committals of cremated remains without the services of a funeral director. The following are the instructions to follow:

1. Contact the Cemetery Operations office to obtain general information, schedule a date and time for the committal, and request the necessary forms. Cemetery Office contacts are:

2. Complete the "Committal Request Form", providing all the pertinent information necessary for the cemetery staff to confirm the committal, locate the plot, complete the burial records, and process payments for cemetery services.
3. The "Committal Request Form" must be accompanied by a burial permit and/or a cremation certificate. Originals of these documents will be copied and returned to the family.
4. The "Committal Request Form" must be signed by a family member granting permission for the Archdiocese to open the plot or niche for the committal.
5. Return the "Committal Request Form", cremation certificate / burial permit for processing to the cemetery operations office (email address stated above).
6. Committals can be made to existing or new ground plots or to a niche in the columbaria at Holy Sepulchre or Mt. Carmel cemetery.
7. For committals in the older cemeteries, the family will be required to meet cemetery staff at the plot to provide specific instructions on where the urn is to be placed.
8. For committals to a ground plot, a wooden liner is required to protect and contain the urn. This can be purchased from the Archdiocese, or the family can provide their own.
9. For committals to a niche in the columbarium, urns must be constructed of 'non-biodegradable' material. Companion urns must have ashes in both compartments before they can be placed in the niche.
10. Cemetery staff will open and prepare the plot/niche for the committal and close the plot/niche afterward. Families are not permitted to open and close plots.
11. All committals are subject to cemetery regulations, provincial legislation, and Canon Law of the Roman Catholic Church.
12. All cemetery fees must be paid before the committal occurs.
13. Fees are paid once the committal forms are completed and all pertinent information is provided. Fees can be paid by credit card, bank draft, or cash. To arrange payment, contact the Cemetery Operations office.
14. For families bringing or sending urns from out of province, they are reminded to secure all necessary documents to satisfy airport and border securities.
